- A 28 year-old pyogenic meningitis; secondary to cervix Ca & intraabdominal abcess .
- A 45 year old Post-COVID19 Pneumocystis jirovecii pneumonitis secondary to undiagnosed HIV/AIDS
- 40 year old HIV infection, with IRIS and JC virus infection
- 76 year old , Varicella Zoster Encephalitis
- A 18 year old, candida endophthalmitis and endocarditis, secondary to CVC infection
- 46 year old, pyogenic osteomyelitis complicating a mesh for inguinal hernie
- Resistant and recurring vaginal candidiasis
- Recurrent meningitis
- Acute and subacute Lyme cases
- Miliary and extrapulmonary tuberculosis
