

Prof. Dr. Süleyman Alici completed his medical education at Ataturk University Faculty of Medicine. (1990) Later, he received his Internal Medicine specialization at Selcuk University Faculty of Medicine, Department of Internal Diseases between 1991-1995. He worked as an Assistant Professor at Yüzüncü Yıl University, Faculty of Medicine, Department of Internal Diseases between 1996-1997. He received his Medical Oncology minor education by working at Istanbul University Faculty of Medicine (Çapa Medicine) between 1997-2000. Later, between 2000-2005, he worked again at Yüzüncü Yıl University Faculty of Medicine and established the Department of Medical Oncology. He was the head of the relevant science department and provided training services to research assistant doctors and student education. There are 2 research assistants thesis advisory in the internal medicine clinic. Receiving the title of Associate Professor in 2004, Mr. Buyer worked as the clinical chief in the Medical Oncology Clinic at Ankara Atatürk Training and Research Hospital between 2005-2008. In the same hospital, he provided the formation and establishment of the Medical Oncology Clinic and gave training to the Medical Oncology sub-branch assistants. He received training in "Dana Farber" Cancer Hospital and "Massachusetts General Hospital" in 2007 on digestive system tumors, breast cancer and lung cancers (Thoracic Cancers) and worked as an observer.

Taking part in the opening and establishment of Medicalpark Göztepe Oncology Hospital (2008-2017), Prof. Dr. Süleyman Ali worked in the Medical Oncology Clinic of Acıbadem Hospital/Altunizade Branch between 2017-2023.

Buyer has more than 70 articles published in international refereed journals and more than 50 scientific studies published in domestic refereed journals. He has over 100 papers presented at national and international scientific meetings. In addition to being a member of European Medical Oncology and American Clinical Oncology associations, he is also a member of Oncology associations in Turkey. There are more than 10 scientific publication incentive awards from TUBITAK and some medical oncology associations.
